DAY 1 Welcome to Israel

Contemplate the sacrifices made by Israeli soldiers and leaders while visiting the gravesites at Mt. Herzl Cemetery, a place of national significance







DAY 4 Volunteer

Engage in meaningful volunteer work at organizations dedicated to providing assistance to those affected by the ongoing conflict, offering your support and solidarity to communities in need. Gain a deeper understanding of the impact of October 7 in Israel through an informative session led by a knowledgeable speaker, fostering empathy and awareness of the challenges faced by the region.







DAY 5 The Desert & Shabbat

Immerse yourself in the therapeutic waters of the Dead Sea. Try covering yourself in its mineral-rich mud, renowned for its skin-nourishing properties, and capture hilarious buoyant photos as you effortlessly float on the water's surface. Finish the day by welcoming in Shabbat at the Western Wall, as you join in the joyful melodies and timeless rituals that mark the beginning of this sacred day.









DAY 6 Gaza Envelope & Tel Aviv

Travel to the Gaza Envelope to learn about the devastation of October 7. Engage in conversations to gain insights and reflect on the complexities of the region's history and the ongoing challenges faced by its inhabitants. Conclude the day by visiting memorial displays in Tel Aviv.







DAY 7 Volunteer

Engage in a day of service by volunteering at organizations committed to aiding those impacted by the ongoing conflict. Embrace the opportunity to listen to insights from Rami Nazzal, a resident of East Jerusalem, offering a firsthand perspective on the complexities of the region's dynamics. Delve deeper into the narratives and experiences that shape the diverse voices within this multifaceted landscape.







DAY 8 Patriarchs, Kings & Prophets

Visit the Southern Steps of the Temple Mount and the site where Jesus overturned the money changers' tables. Explore the ancient City of David, tracing the footsteps of ancient civilizations and uncovering layers of Jerusalem's rich heritage. Conclude your day with a stroll through the markets of Jerusalem.







DAY 9 New Covenant Day

Walk down the Palm Sunday Road on the Mt. of Olives to the Garden of Gethsemane. Walk along the Via Dolorosa to the Christian Quarter and the Church of the Holy Sepulchre, the traditional site of the crucifixion and burial of Jesus, before ending with a devotional at the Garden Tomb.
