# JAN 3



#### Welcome to Israel






### **Neighbor's North and Golan Briefing**

We will embark on an insightful tour exploring Israel's northern border, beginning with a comprehensive briefing on the region's geopolitical dynamics and security challenges. Next, we will enjoy panoramic views from Mount Bental alongside a fascinating talk by Col. Eyal Dror, the visionary leader of the Good Neighbor project, shedding light on the humanitarian efforts and cross-border cooperation in support of Syrian civilians during the civil war. This immersive experience will give you a profound understanding of the region's history, sacrifices, and ongoing pursuit of peace.

### JAN 5



#### **The Ministry of Jesus**

After breakfast at the hotel, we will head to Capernaum, where we will explore the ruins of what is believed to be the home of St. Peter's mother-in-law and the ministry headquarters for Jesus. From there to Magdala the home of Mary Magdelene and first centry synogouge from the time of Jesus and a beautiful church from this century nearby. From there we will depart the Galilee and make our way to Jerusalem following the route that Jesus took, stopping at Jericho along the way. We will finish our day at a host family in Jerusalem where we will welcome the Sabbath by eating dinner and celebrating the day of rest.

# JAN 6





#### **New Covenant**

We will embark on a soul-stirring tour of Jerusalem, starting with a scenic overlook from the Mount of Olives, where you can take in the breathtaking panorama of the ancient city. Next, descend to the Garden of Gethsemane, where Jesus prayed before his crucifixion, and explore its serene surroundings. Next, continue to the Via Dolorosa, retracing the path that Jesus walked while carrying the cross, and visit significant stations along the route, such as the Chapel of the Flagellation and the Church of the Holy Sepulchre, where Jesus was crucified, buried, and resurrected. Conclude the tour at the tranquil Garden Tomb, believed by some to be the actual burial site of Jesus, offering a reflective and contemplative experience.

### JAN 7





#### The Ancient and Modern

The complete Isaiah scroll found in the caves of Qumran is housed in the Shrine of the Book, where we will begin our day. Afterwards, we will hear from a few members of the Israeli Defense Force and discuss the current threats that Israel faces and the strategies they use. Finally we will enjoy an exclusive underground tour from the City of David-Israel's most famous warrior king.

# JAN 8





#### Yad Vashem and Victory

Our day will begin with a poignant visit to Yad Vashem, Israel's renowned Holocaust memorial, and delve into the stories of survival and remembrance. After a moment of reflection we will visit the sites of Israel's modern wars, and learn how modern Israel has defended itself against its enemies.
